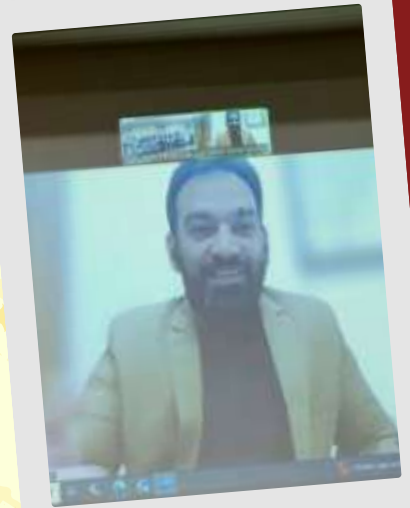
## "Sustainability in Business: Insights from Dr. Mohd Salman Shamsi" December' 12
