1. Interview with Pivush Singh, Placed at SBI General Insurance Designation: Management Trainee Batch: 2022

Q1: How was your journey at SIBM Nagpur?

GUEST LECTURE HIGHLIGHTS

 Guest Lecture by Mr. Jai Balan- SIBM Pune Alumnus(2003)

Topic: "Navigating the Corporate ladder"

This session focused on guiding students through the journey of progressing within an organization. The speaker highlighted key strategies and habits that contribute to career growth:

- Building Personal Brand: The importance of creating a unique professional identity through consistent performance, networking, and demonstrating expertise in one's domain.
- Networking: Developing meaningful relationships across organizational levels, both internally and externally, to access mentorship, career opportunities, and visibility.
- Skill Development: Regularly upgrading technical, managerial, and interpersonal skills to stay relevant and prepared for leadership roles.
- Taking Initiative: Standing out by volunteering for challenging assignments, proposing innovative solutions, and consistently exceeding expectations.
- Adaptability and Resilience: Managing changes and setbacks in the corporate world with a positive outlook and proactive problem-solving.

The speaker also addressed common obstacles like imposter syndrome and office politics and offered practical solutions to overcome them.

 Guest Lecture by Mr. Aniket Kumar- SIBM Nagpur Alumnus(2024)

Topic: "CV/ Resume building"

CV/Resume Building Tips for MBA Graduates This lecture equipped MBA students with actionable advice to craft compelling resumes that catch recruiters' attention:

- Understanding the Employer's Perspective: Students learned to tailor their resumes to highlight skills and experiences that align with job descriptions.
- Structuring the Resume: The speaker emphasized using a clear, professional format with sections such as a summary, education, work experience, skills, and achievements.
- Showcasing Achievements: Focusing on quantifiable accomplishments, such as "Increased sales by 25% in Q4," rather than listing responsibilities.

- Keywords and ATS Optimization: Including industry-relevant keywords to ensure compatibility with applicant tracking systems (ATS).
- Avoiding Common Mistakes: Avoiding errors like using generic templates, including irrelevant information, or exceeding a one-page format for entry-level positions.

The session concluded with tips on creating a LinkedIn profile that complements the resume and increases visibility to potential recruiters.

 Guest Lecture by Ms. Divkiran Kathuria- SIBM Pune Alumnus(2008)

Topic: "Campus to Corporate"

Campus to Corporate Life

This session bridged the gap between academic life and corporate environments, preparing students for the cultural and behavioral shift:

- Differences in Work Environment: The speaker discussed how corporate life demands independence, accountability, and the ability to thrive under deadlines, unlike the guided environment of college.
- Professional Communication: Tips on writing professional emails, participating in meetings effectively, and communicating with colleagues and superiors.
- Time and Task Management: Using tools like calendars, task prioritization, and project management techniques to meet corporate expectations.
- Adapting to Organizational Culture: Understanding workplace ethics, adapting to team dynamics, and building rapport with colleagues while maintaining professionalism.
- Growth Mindset: The speaker stressed the importance of continual learning, accepting feedback, and proactively seeking opportunities for growth in a new work environment.

Real-life anecdotes and practical exercises were included to make students feel more confident about their transition to corporate roles.
